Mathematics and Numeracy

- Place value
 - Practise counting forwards and backwards to 20 in Welsh and English and within 50.
 - Practise counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s
- Addition and Subtraction
 - Practise number bonds to 10 and 20
- Shape and Measure
 - Measure the length or height of small trees or bushes, sticks, twigs and leaves found in your garden, local park or woodland.
