Health and Well-being

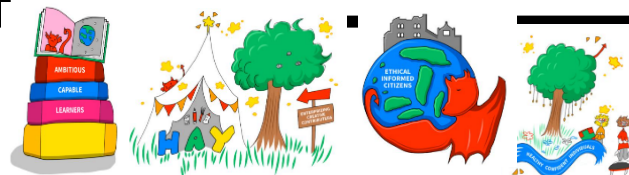
- Go for a walk and see if you can spot some signs of Autumn.
